Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The Department does not currently track requests to source materials from within the right-of-way, so the exact usage and costs are unknown.

Before allowing the usage of materials sourced from within the right-of-way, the environmental impact must be analyzed due to the loss of or change to the materials in the highway right-of-way. The Department assumes it will conduct the environmental analyses, rather than the contractor, to safeguard its existing responsibilities required by cooperative agreements with other agencies, which may be jeopardized if protocols are not properly followed. If the Department allowed the contractor to perform this environmental impact analysis the direct costs to the Department would be reduced.

This estimate was built using the following per project historical costs in the environmental analysis areas. All areas include costs for: preliminary desktop screening, field surveys, and consultation with other agencies, such as Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and Wisconsin Historical Preservation Office. Below are the average and median per-project costs for the environmental analysis:

Archeological & History Average Cost: \$20,500 Endangered Species Average Cost: \$18,500 Wetland Delineation Average Cost: \$13,000

Hazardous Materials Investigation Average Cost: \$25,000 Total Environmental Analysis Average: \$77,000 per project

Over the next 6-years, for Fiscal Years 2021-2026, the Department anticipates approximately 1,227 transportation projects. Upon review of historical environmental documentation, the Department believes any request to use sourcing materials from the right-of-way would most likely be seen on larger projects and also require a higher level of improvement to the roadway. As such, the Department estimates that a range of 10-20% projects could have a request to source materials from the Department's right-of-way. The Department offers the below assumptions, applying the above environmental analyses costs:

1,227 total projects/6 years = 204 projects annually (estimated)

- •10% of 204 = 20 projects x \$77,000 average environmental = \$1,540,000 annual costs
- •20% of 204 = 40 projects x \$77,000 average environmental = \$3,080,000 annual costs

These numbers are based off the assumption that the Department's resource needs in the areas affected by the proposed bill, would be equal to or greater than what has historically been spent on projects.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The estimated annual costs would continue in future years.
