### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes several changes to laws related to operating while under the influence ("OWI") for motor vehicles as well as all-terrain and utility-terrain vehicles, off-highway motorcycles, snowmobiles, and motorboats ("off-highway vehicles"). The bill makes the provisions of the intoxicated operation of off-highway vehicles laws more consistent.

The bill proposes to increase the net consequences for individuals convicted of OWI offenses, most notably the potential suspension/revocation of driver's license privileges. Therefore, given that the consequences to defendants are higher under the bill than under current law, defendants may utilize additional legal processes, including jury trials, and legal motions in defending prosecution. The number of these OWI cases is minimal. The fiscal impact on the court is negligible and indeterminate.

Fiscal Effect – Costs/Savings: The Director of State Courts has determined that the implementation of this bill would incur indeterminate, one-time GPR costs.

This bill will incur one-time implementation costs to make the substantial number of statute table changes required by this bill; update publications and website materials; create new procedures and trainings for judges and clerks; and provide training to judges and clerks.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implication of this bill is indeterminate.
