### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates an appropriation but provides no funding to award grants to law enforcement agencies to purchase body cameras for officers primarily assigned to patrol duties.

The Department of Justice is required to administer and award the grant funds, including establishing criteria, reviewing and awarding grants based on application submissions, and enforcing matching requirements, implementation deadlines, and equipment usage and maintenance requirements. The department will require additional staff to establish and administer the grant program and enforce the grant requirements, however, the number of additional positions is dependent on the amount of the grant funding and the number of grants awarded. An estimate has been provided for 1.0 full-time equivalent position for a small to moderate scale grant program, but additional staffing will be required for a statewide or large-scale program similar to the School Safety Grant Program which required four additional positions.

If this is a one-time grant program, the duties could be performed by a four-year project position instead of a permanent position based on the three-year term of the grant requirements.

In addition, the department is required to consult with vendors of body cameras within 90 days of enactment to identify cost-saving measures that law enforcement agencies may use when applying for the grant, and to work with the Department of Administration to develop options for reducing the cost of storing body camera data. These responsibilities can be completed with existing resources.

Local law enforcement agencies may receive additional revenue to offset the cost of the purchase of body cameras, less the match requirement.

#### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The department will incur ongoing costs for a minimum of 1.0 full-time equivalent position to award grants and enforce the requirements of the grants.
