Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes various changes to the Clean Water Fund Program (CWFP) and Safe Drinking Water Loan Program (SDWLP) application process. Specific changes include the elimination of the requirement to submit a notice of intent to apply before applying for both programs; allowing a municipality to submit more than one application per year for the same project for both programs; correction of a procedural inaccuracy in the timing of engineering report submittals; and the removal of statutory application and loan closing deadlines for the SDWLP.

State Fiscal Effect

The bill would have a minimal fiscal impact on the Department. It makes procedural changes to the process of applying for CWFP and SDWLP financial assistance that will likely give local units of government more flexibility and the DNR greater ability to adapt the CWFP and SDWLP to customer needs.

- 1. The Department would incur estimated one-time salary and fringe costs of \$5,500 (120 hours of staff time) for customer outreach and to update CWFP and SDWLP guidance materials.
- 2. There is potential for the bill to generate minimal, but indeterminate, cost savings as the result of a more streamlined loan application and closing process.
