Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 549 directs the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) to award grants in an amount of up to \$500,000 in each fiscal year to health care providers to develop and implement a tool that would allow prescribers to disclose the cost ofprescription drugs for patients. The tool must be usable by physicians and other prescribers to determine the cost of prescription drugs for their patients. Any health care provider that receives a grant to develop and implement a patient pharmacy benefits tool is required to contribute matching funds equal to at least 50 percent of the total grant awarded.

At this time, OCI cannot determine the fiscal effect this legislation will have on staff time and agency resources.
