Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2021 AB 573 requires the governor to allocate \$70.0 million of funds accepted under the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) to the Public Service Commission (Commission) to award grants for constructing wireless broadband and cellular service infrastructure. 2021 AB 573 requires the Commission to give priority to proposed projects that expand wireless broadband service or cellular service to areas designated by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) as unserved or underserved. The bill also requires grant recipients to contribute matching funds of at least 20 percent of the grant. The ARPA-funded grants must be awarded by October 1, 2024. Any unspent funds must be distributed to cities, villages and towns in equal amounts for making technological investments.

4.0 project positions are needed to successfully and responsibly administer the program. Staff activities will include program development, outreach, technical assistance, application and program evaluation, as well as grant recipient monitoring. The cost associated with 4.0 project positions is \$426,400, as detailed below:

Salary: \$247,500

Fringe Benefits: \$126,900 Supplies and Services: \$52,000

Total: \$426,400

2021 AB 573 also allocates \$5.0 million of ARPA funds to the Commission to establish and maintain a publicly accessible map of broadband service availability. The bill requires fixed, mass market broadband service provides to disclose to the Commission information on the properties served and technology type, consistent with FCC mapping requirements. The Commission shall use this data to update the availability map twice each year. 2021 AB 573 allows the Commission to contract with a private vendor to establish and maintain the map. 1.0 FTE is needed to develop and manage vendor contract(s) related to mapping activities, which may include acquisition of coverage data and an intelligence platform. The FTE will also assist with overall map development and data integrity. The cost associated with 1.0 FTE is \$116,900, as detailed below:

Salary: \$77,000

Fringe Benefits: \$26,900

Supplies and Services: \$13,000

Total: \$116,900

The eligibility of ARPA funds for these purposes would need to be validated.
