## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill eliminates the right to a jury trial in a termination of parental rights (TPR) proceeding for a child or the child's parent, guardian, or legal custodian. The elimination of a jury trial in a TPR proceeding may affect the amount of time a child spends in out-of-home care. To the extent that this legislation does affect the amount of time a child stays in out-of-home care, there may be corresponding costs or savings for county child welfare agencies and the Department's Division of Milwaukee Child Protective Services (DMCPS). The Department is unable to estimate the effect of this legislation on the overall timing of TPR proceedings, thus the state and local fiscal effect is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
