Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This proposal extends the period in which a parent can relinquish a newborn child, known as safe haven laws, to apply to newborn children up to 30 days old. The bill requires changes to birth records for relinquished newborn which impacts the Vital Records Office within the Department of Health Services. Vital Records staff have expressed concerns regarding records not being accurately filed given that multiple individuals would be required to file safe haven birth records. Vital records staff also have concerns regarding the ability to accurately identify existing birth records for a relinquished child. However, the impact on staff time and records changes would be minimal and have no ongoing fiscal impact.
