Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides \$10,000,000 to the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection in fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 from the general fund for grants to food banks, food pantries, and other nonprofit organizations to purchase Wisconsin food products. It would also provide funding to the UW System; for state aid for technical colleges; and for special education the Department of Public Instruction pays.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Under this bill the General Program Operations appropriation to the Board of Regents of the UW System would be increased by \$1,295,600 in 2021-22 and 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
