## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill creates a farm to fork program. The bill authorizes 1.0 position to administer the program. The bill provides \$265,700 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$287,600 in fiscal year 2022-23 for grants and the additional position.

The bill increases the appropriation for farm to school grants by \$200,000 each fiscal year in the 21-23 biennium.

DATCP is unable to determine the local fiscal effect of the other provisions in the bill.
