## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection administers the "Something Special from Wisconsin" promotional campaign to promote commodities produced in this state. The bill creates a new continuing appropriation and provides \$400,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 from the general fund for this purpose.

This bill transfers a total of \$252,000 to s. 20.255 (2) (b) to increase the annual GPR appropriation aids for special education under s. 115.88 in fiscal year 2021-22. This would increase the appropriation from \$468,091,800 to \$468,343,800 in FY22.

This would increase the payments paid under the appropriation by the Department of Public Instruction to school districts, independent charter schools, cooperative educational service agencies, and county children with disabilities education boards distributed by the funding formulas.
