Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides \$400,000 to the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection in fiscal year 2021-22 from the general fund for the "Something Special from Wisconsin" promotional campaign to promote commodities produced in Wisconsin. It would also provide funding to the UW System; for state aid for technical colleges; and for special education the Department of Public Instruction pays.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Under this bill the General Program Operations appropriation to the Board of Regents of the UW System would be increased by \$51,660 in 2021-22. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
