Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides detailed programmatic guidelines for the freshwater collaborative and requires metrics for determining the success of the program to be submitted to the Joint Committee on Finance (JCF). It also requires the Board of Regents to appoint a nine-member committee to advise the board on how to allocate the funding, and to provide the legislature with a biennial report showing how the funding was distributed and expended at each institution.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implications are indeterminant as the freshwater collaborative is dependent on the funding that is available in appropriation 20.285 (1) (ar) Freshwater Collaborative.

2021 Wisconsin Act 58 provided \$2,500,000 GPR in both 2021-22 and 2022-23 in the JFC supplemental appropriation for a freshwater collaborative which may be released to the UW System.
