Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill creates an income and franchise tax exemption for income received in the form of a grant from the Restaurant Revitalization Fund established by the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Under the bill, expenses used with the grant money may still be deducted from taxable income.

Fiscal Estimate

After a review of the Restaurant Revitalization Grant data from the U.S. Small Business Administration and 2019 tax returns, the bill will decrease revenues by an estimated \$15.6 million in FY2022, \$7.5 million in FY2023, and \$4.1 million in FY2024.
