Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides \$599,700 in 2021-22 and 7.0 FTE, and \$716,300 in 2022-23 to increase services under the veterans outreach and recovery programs at the Department of Veterans Affairs. Due to the maintenance of effort requirements of the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act for the federal American Rescue Plan Act, it would also provide additional funding for the UW System and special education aid through the Department of Public Instruction.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The UW System's general program operations appropriation would be increased by \$95,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$115,000 in 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
