Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 757 creates a nonresident tuition exemption at Wisconsin Technical Colleges for a person who is the child or spouse of a relocated active duty member of the US armed forces if:

- the person has been accepted for admission to a technical college,
- the service member resided in the state at the time the person was accepted for admission, but the service member was subsequently relocated and stationed in another state, and
- after the person's admission and initial enrollment, the person has remained continuously enrolled in the technical college.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If the proposed legislation was enacted, the Wisconsin Technical College System districts would see a small reduction in tuition revenue.
