Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill allows the department to research chronic wasting disease (CWD) in cervids--defined as any species of deer or elk that is present in the wild and that is not a farm-raised deer--in addition to managing, and providing funding to conduct testing for CWD. The bill also provides \$1.0 million of annual GPR funding in FY2022 and FY2023 for research and management of CWD.

State Fiscal Effect

Annual CWD-related expenditures are estimated to increase by \$1.0 million, which corresponds to the funding provided in the bill.
