Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the department to provide large metal containers where hunters may dispose of deer carcasses, to be placed in locations throughout the state as determined by DNR. In addition, the bill provides \$1 million/yr. for the carcass disposal sites and \$50,000/yr. to provide education to hunters about chronic wasting disease and the importance of proper carcass disposal.

State Fiscal Effect

Fish and Wildlife Account expenditures for deer carcass disposal and for CWD-related hunter education efforts would be expected to increase by \$1,050,000/yr., which corresponds to the additional funding provided in the bill.
