Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Wisconsin Climate Corps (WCC) program and a Wisconsin Climate Corps Board which is attached to the Department of Administration. It also provides \$50,000,000 to the Department of Administration for Climate Corps program sponsor grants. Due to the maintenance of effort requirements of the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act and the federal American Rescue Plan Act, it would also provide additional funding to the UW System.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The UW System's general program operations appropriation would be increased by \$4,000,000 in 2021-22 and 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
