Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-143 requires the Board of the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) to ensure that each of the 16 WTCS district boards offers students an opportunity to use hours engaged in an eligible activity to satisfy related course requirements to the extent appropriate, as determined by the district board. An "eligible activity" is defined as volunteering or working, for at least one semester, to assist Wisconsin in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic. A similar provision is required of the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The fiscal estimate of this bill is unclear until program guidelines are established. Additionally, there may be accreditation and licensing requirements to consider.
