Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill enables the Department of Administration, Division of Personnel Management to increase or suspend the total number of hours allowed by law for a limited term employee (LTE) appointment for the period beginning March 12, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021.

The Department of Military Affairs utilizes LTEs and would add additional cost to the department; however, that amount it indeterminate due to the inability to know how many hours over the current 1,040 hours allowed by law will be required to meet work responsibilities.
