### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate is submitted by the Director of the State Prosecutors Office on behalf of Agency 475 – District Attorneys. This fiscal estimate is responsive only to the fiscal and resource effect of the proposed legislation on the District Attorney program.

This bill requires the Department of Corrections to recommend revoking a person's extended supervision, parole, or probation if the person is charged with a crime while on release.

This bill also modifies the law related to expungement:

- a. The bill adds that the court may not order the record expunged of a crime if the person had previously been convicted of a crime, including a crime for which the record had been expunged.
- b. The bill adds that a person has not completed his or her sentence (for purposes of expungement) if criminal charges are pending against the person or, if the person was on probation, the person violated any rule or condition of the probation or at least one year has not elapsed since being placed on probation.

District Attorney offices do not anticipate a significant fiscal effect on their offices resulting from this proposed bill.
