## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2021 SB 278 requires the Governor to allocate \$500,000,000 of federal funds received under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 for making broadband expansion grants. Under the bill the Commission shall award \$125,000,000 in each calendar year beginning with 2021 and ending in 2024. 2021 SB 278 also requires the Commission to submit an annual report to the Joint Committee on Finance detailing evaluation criteria, grant recipients and the evaluation of the recipient applications.

The Commission requires additional staff resources to successfully and prudently administer the broadband expansion grant program at this funding level. Accurate coverage maps are a vital tool for the Commissioners when they make grant award decisions. Therefore, additional staff resources are necessary to ensure that mapping data is as up to date as possible and accurately reflects ongoing projects. This is especially important as funding levels and funding sources increase and an increasing number of projects are in the construction phase. In addition, the Commission is committed to administering a program with strong performance and fiscal monitoring controls. As such, additional staff resources are needed to perform critical tasks throughout the grant life cycle, from grant round planning to reporting and accountability analyses upon project completion. The additional staff resources will ensure the ongoing financial integrity of the program and will allow the Commission to maintain the highest standard for strategic investment. The cost associated with the 4.0 FTE needed to administer this additional funding is \$377,366.

This fiscal estimate reflects the cost and additional FTEs associated with administering the broadband expansion grants funded under this bill and are in addition to those included in 2021 SB 111. The estimate does not reflect costs associated with other key aspects of broadband access including affordability, local outreach, technical assistance, digital inclusion programming and internet adoption support.
