Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits discrimination on the basis of vaccination status, in employment, housing, and in jury selection. In addition, the bill would require the executive branch of state government to determine whether there is arbitrary discrimination on the basis of vaccination status. Further, the bill adds prohibitions against employees and persons in treatment, mental health services or vocational rehabilitation services, and for the purposes of insurance coverage, among others.

The bill could add additional workload to the courts on the basis of whether such discrimination exists, in the event a claim reaches the courts.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implications of the bill are indeterminate.
