Re: Social and Financial Impact Report—2021 Senate Bill 40 relating to coverage of individuals with preexisting conditions and benefit limits under health plans

Dear Chief Clerk Queensland and Ms. Martyn:

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 601.423, the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) is submitting this letter regarding a social and financial impact report on 2021 Senate Bill 40 relating to coverage of individuals with preexisting conditions and benefit limits under health plans.

OCI is not intending to prepare a social and financial impact report as allowed under Wis. Stat. §13.0966 (2) (b) since it has been determined the bill does not:

- 1. Permit an insured to seek coverage from a specific type of provider,
- 2. Require coverage or a specific benefit design for a particular disease, condition or other healthcare need;
- 3. Require coverage of a particular treatment, equipment or drug;
- 4. Require coverage for a particular person because of their relation to the insured.
