Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a foster parents' bill of rights and requires a licensing agency to provide a copy of the foster parents' bill of rights to a foster parent when the foster parent is licensed. The Department of Children and Families assumes that the rights provided to foster parents under this bill are meant to reflect existing rights that are already codified in statute and administrative rule. To the extent the bill deviates from current law or creates ambiguity, there could be additional costs related to litigation, training, and changes to the eWiSACWIS child welfare information system; however, the magnitude of these costs is presently unknown. Thus, the state and local fiscal estimates are indeterminate.
