## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-423 eliminates the different per pupil amount paid to independent charter schools authorized by a tribal college. Beginning in the 2021-22 school year, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) will pays the same per pupil amount to all independent charter schools under SB-423 regardless of the authorizer. Currently, for the 2020-21 school year, the per pupil amount DPI pays to an independent charter school authorized by a tribal college is \$8,719, while the amount DPI pays to an independent charter school authorized by an authorizer other than a tribal college is \$9,165.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

None. Under state law, all 16 Wisconsin Technical Colleges are authorized to establish an independent charter school. To date, none have done so.
