Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, to be certified as a qualified bidder, a bidder must demonstrate that it has completed at least one similar project of at least 50 percent of the size or value of the project being bid. The Department of Administration (DOA) may include additional requirements and certify bidders accordingly if it determines that more experience is necessary for a particular project.

The bill would delete the requirement that a bidder must have completed at least one similar project of at least 50 percent of the size or value of the project being bid to be considered a qualified bidder. The bill would prohibit DOA from requiring the bidder to have completed a project with a minimum size or value in relation to the project being bid. However, under the bill, DOA could include other additional requirements if it determines that specific experience directly related to the project being bid is necessary.

Current law establishing requirements for a bidder to be certified as a responsible bidder, including the requirement that the bidder demonstrate that it is bondable for the term for the proposed contract and is able to obtain both a 100 percent performance bond and a 100 percent payment bond, would not be modified by the bill.

The bill would not provide funding to DOA; therefore, it is expected that existing staff would absorb the duties associated with certifying bidders under the modified requirements. The extent to which the changes would affect state costs is indeterminate.
