Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill directs the Department of Health Services to award \$2,500,000 in grants to free and charitable clinics. If the grants are awarded it would provide additional funding to the Department of Public Instruction for aids for special education, the UW System, and technical colleges.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If the grants are fully awarded the General Program Operations appropriation to the Board of Regents of the UW System would be increased by \$335,800 for the fiscal year in which the grants are awarded. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
