## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill creates a civil cause of action under Chapter 895 against the owner or operator of a social media Internet site that is available to the public and that has more than 150 million users if the site deletes or censors, fails to notify a user that their speech has been deleted or censored, fails to allow a user to retrieve their information from the site, fails to publish standard for deleting and censoring, applies standards inconsistently, makes changes to user rules more than once every 180 days, and fails to provide a mechanism for a user to request the number of other users who were provided or shown the user's content or posts and provide that number to the user upon request.

The attorney general or any district attorney to commence a civil cause of action to the courts, and the bill sets statutory damages at a minimum of \$75,000, along with the possibility of injunctive relief.

The number of civil cases that might be heard by the court is unknown, and as a result, the fiscal impact is indeterminate. Judges would be required to be educated on the impact on the law, which would require additional staff time and resources.
