Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill decriminalizes the use of fentanyl testing strips to test a substance for fentanyl and specifically excludes them from "drug paraphernalia" under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act. The effect of the bill would be to remove them from being identified as drug paraphernalia because they would otherwise be identified as such as testing equipment to determine the strength, effectiveness or purity of a controlled substance, which includes fentanyl.

This bill has no fiscal effect.
