Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill transfers a total of \$7,685,000 to s. 20.255 (2) (b) to increase the annual GPR appropriation aids for special education under s. 115.88 in fiscal year 2021-22. This would increase the appropriation from \$468,091,800 to \$475,776,800 in FY22. An increase of \$7,685,000 for the 2022-23 fiscal year is included. This would increase the appropriation from \$517,890,000 to \$525,575,000 in FY23.

This would increase the payments paid under the appropriation by the Department of Public Instruction to school districts, independent charter schools, cooperative educational service agencies, and county children with disabilities education boards distributed by the funding formulas.

Increase to appropriation s. 20.255 (2) (b) Aids for special education and school age parents program by \$7,685,000 in FY2021-22 and \$7,685,000 in FY2022-23

Increase to appropriate will increase distributed aids to LEAs based on formulas.
