Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-648 provides additional funding to the Wisconsin Technical College System for state aid to Wisconsin's 16 technical colleges. The bill increases the state aid appropriation s.20.292(1)(d) by an additional \$284,400 in funding for FY2021-22 and an additional \$284,400 in funding for FY2022-23. State aid is distributed to the 16 technical colleges based on a statutory formula.
