## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides \$265,700 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$287,600 in fiscal year 2022-23 to the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection from the general fund for farm to fork program grants. It would also provide funding to the UW System; for state aid for technical colleges; and for special education the Department of Public Instruction pays.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Under this bill the General Program Operations appropriation to the Board of Regents of the UW System would be increased by \$61,000 in 2021-22 and \$63,000 in 2022-23. The funding would be used for strategic initiatives identified by the President and Board of Regents.
