**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill would require the UW System and technical colleges to refund a student's current and previously charged tuition and fees associated with their enrollment in a program if a COVID-19 vaccine is required and certain exemptions are refused, resulting in the student not being able to participate in the program.
