Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed legislation requires a Wisconsin Technical College to refund to a student all current and previously charged tuition and fees associated with the students enrollment in a program if the following apply:

- The technical college requires the student to be vaccinated against COVID-19 as a condition of participation;
- The technical college refuses an exemption for the student to this requirement to accommodate the student's sincerely held religious beliefs or personal convictions; or
- The technical college prohibits the student from participation in the program because of the student's failure to be vaccinated against COVID-19 and the student's participation is therefore temporarily or permanently discontinued.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If the proposed legislation is enacted, it is unknown how many technical college students have been impacted by the provisions outlined under the bill and the local fiscal effect is indeterminate.
