Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Board of Regents to provide a nonresident tuition exemption to students that are the children of UW System alumni. A surcharge of up to 20% could be established by the Board of Regents.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

While a definitive estimate cannot be developed until the program guidelines are established, the UW System estimates this could result in more than a \$50,000,000 decrease in tuition revenue for the System.
