Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires each department in the executive branch of state government to, no later than July 1, 2022, develop and maintain a publicly available dashboard on its Internet site, or on an Internet site maintained by the Department of Administration, that reports on the department's performance of its core functions. Under the bill, the dashboards must be updated on a quarterly basis, and, to the extent practicable, each department must engage stakeholders in discussions about the department's performance. The performance metrics each department uses for its dashboard must include the performance metrics the department used for its dashboard as of July 1, 2018, under 2016 Executive Order No. 189, which included requirements similar to the bill.

The Department estimates that it will need 600 hours for dashboard development, which will be obtained through recruitment of a 0.6 Limited Term Employee (LTE) that will result in a one-time costs totaling \$29,900 for salary, fringe, and overhead. This amount cannot be absorbed within DSPS's current appropriated funding. DSPS additionally estimates annual cost of \$3,500 for salary, fringe, and overhead for maintenance and verification and filing quarterly updates as required by the bill. This annual amount can be absorbed within agency resources.
