EmR 2019 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: certification courses for funeral director apprentices - allowing remote instruction for the course required for certification (Funeral Directors Examining Board).

EmR 2023 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: continuing education and youth apprenticeship programs (DSPA).

EmR 2030 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: Veterans assistance grants (DVA).

EmR 2031 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: emergency medical services licensure, certification, and staffing requirements (DHS).

EmR 2033 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: Medicaid eligibility requirements (DHS).

EmR 2032 [60-Day Extension Request]

Relating to: financial responsibility for engineering controls for contaminated sediment remediation, and insurance and financial responsibility for Voluntary Party Liability Exemption projects with contaminated sediments; Chapters NR 700, 725, 726, 727, 750, 754, 756, 758, Wis Adm. Code (DNR).

Relating to: sponsors of nutritional counseling education programs and repealing and modifying administrative rules related to sponsors of nutritional counseling education programs and the objection to CR 19-100, an administrative rule of the Chiropractic Examining Board.

Relating to: rules defining unprofessional conduct by marriage and family therapists, professional counselors, and social workers and the objection to CR 19-166, an administrative rule of the MPSW Examining Board.
