2021 Assembly Bill 1026

Assembly Amendment 1

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 1026

Assembly Bill 1026 is a Law Revision Committee bill suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Transportation (DOT). In pertinent part, the bill addresses the registration fee for a motorcycle or moped.

Current law imposes a biennial registration fee of \$23 for each motorcycle or moped with a curb weight of 1,499 pounds or less. The bill strikes the reference to the curb weight of these vehicles from the registration fee provision on the basis that the definitions of “motorcycle” and “moped” that generally apply throughout motor vehicle law, including the registration fee provisions, do not specify a curb weight for these vehicles.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 removes this provision from the bill.

BILL HISTORY

The Law Revision Committee introduced Assembly Bill 1026 on February 17, 2022. Representative August, Co-Chair of the Law Revision Committee, offered Assembly Amendment 1 on February 22, 2022. The Assembly adopted the amendment and passed the bill, as amended, by voice votes on February 23, 2022.
