2021 Assembly Bill 365

Assembly Amendment 1

Current law limits the type, placement, and color of lights that may be displayed on an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) or a utility terrain vehicle (UTV).

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 365

2021 Assembly Bill 365 allows a person to operate an ATV or UTV with a “whip light” attached. A whip light is a series of lights arranged vertically along a flexible rod with the emitted light visible from any direction approaching the vehicle.

A whip light may emit any color of light in a fixed display, or emit any color of light in a pattern or sequence except flashing red or flashing blue.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 does not allow the use of a whip light that emits red or blue light, whether flashing or in a fixed display.

BILL HISTORY

On November 17, 2021, the Assembly Committee on Transportation introduced Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 11; Noes, 0. The committee then recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes 11; Noes, 0, and passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 6; Noes, 5.
