2021 Assembly Bill 481

Assembly Amendment 1

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 481

2021 Assembly Bill 481 establishes a vehicle registration system for a fleet of 10 or more automobiles or motor trucks with a gross vehicle weight of not more than 8,000 pounds. In addition to the regular annual registration fee for each vehicle, the Department of Transportation (DOT) would charge the owner of the fleet an initial issuance fee of \$8.50 for the initial registration of each vehicle.

The bill increases by \$85,000 in each of fiscal years 2021-22 and 2022-23 the appropriation to DOT for its vehicle registration, inspection and maintenance, and driver licensing and aircraft registration account.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 removes the appropriation to DOT for its vehicle registration, inspection and maintenance, and driver licensing and aircraft registration account.

BILL HISTORY

The Joint Committee on Finance introduced Assembly Amendment 1 on October 19, 2021. On the same day, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 11; Noes, 4, and passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0.
