2021 Assembly Bill 517

**Assembly Substitute
Amendment 1**

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 517

2021 Assembly Bill 517 expands the definition of “environmental pollution” as that term is used with respect to an environmental remediation tax incremental district created under s. 66.1105 (20m) or 66.1106, Stats. In particular, the bill expands the definition to include harmful substances that are released into the air, land, or waters of the state due to redevelopment of an existing structure.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 expands the definition of environmental pollution in the same manner as 2021 Assembly Bill 517, but only as that term is used with respect to an environmental remediation tax incremental district created under s. 66.1105 (20m), Stats. Section 66.1106 (15), Stats., specifies that new environmental remediation tax incremental districts may not be created under s. 66.1106, Stats., after November 29, 2017.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Armstrong introduced 2021 Assembly Bill 517 on August 31, 2021, and introduced Assembly Substitute Amendment 1, on October 6, 2021. On October 20, 2021, the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means recommended adoption of Assembly Substitute Amendment 1, and passage of Assembly Bill 517, as amended, on successive votes of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0.
