2021 Assembly Bill 833

**Assembly
Amendment 1**

2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 833

2021 Assembly Bill 833 provides grants to local law enforcement agencies that employ 24 or fewer employees to provide qualifying supplies and medical testing to part-time law enforcement officers. “Qualifying supplies” means equipment worn by a law enforcement officer that is required to perform the duties of a law enforcement officer. “Medical testing” includes a physical exam, hearing test, drug test, and pre-employment psychological exam that is required for employment as a law enforcement officer.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 removes the requirement that the grants be used only for part-time law enforcement officers, allowing the funds to be used for qualifying supplies and medical testing for any law enforcement officer by an eligible local law enforcement agency.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Dallman introduced Assembly Amendment 1 on January 14, 2022. On January 18, 2022, the Assembly Committee on Criminal Justice recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 4; and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 833, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 5.
