2021 Assembly Bill 89

Assembly Amendment 1

2021 Assembly Bill 89 requires the Governor to submit to the Legislature a plan for when all state employees holding positions with duties that were required to be performed at the offices of the agency on March 1, 2020, will return to and perform those duties at the offices with that agency. Under the bill, the plan must be submitted by February 28, 2021.

Assembly Amendment 1 to the bill modifies the due date for the plan so that it must be submitted to the Legislature no later than 21 days after the effective date of the legislation.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by Representative Rozar on March 5, 2021. On March 9, 2021, the Assembly Committee on Government Accountability and Oversight recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0, and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 3.
