**2021 Senate Bill 237**

**Senate Amendment 1**

### **2021 SENATE BILL 237**

Current law prohibits a person from operating a drone over a correctional institution. Senate Bill 237 creates an exception to this prohibition for persons with express authorization from the secretary of the Department of Corrections (DOC) or his or her designee.

### **SENATE AMENDMENT 1**

Senate Amendment 1 clarifies that a person may operate a drone over an institution that is a state facility with the express authorization of the DOC secretary or his or her designee, or over an institution that is a county facility with the express authorization of the county sheriff or his or her designee.

### **BILL HISTORY**

Senator Feyen offered Senate Amendment 1 on April 22, 2021. On May 6, 2021, the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety recommended adoption of the amendment, and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
