2021 Senate Bill 343

Senate Amendment 1

2021 SENATE BILL 343

2021 Senate Bill 343 authorizes the use of a prefilled epinephrine syringe, in the same manner as authorized under current law for an epinephrine auto-injector in schools and other settings. The bill also specifies that the Department of Health Services or a person with prescribing authority may issue a standing order to dispense epinephrine to persons who have completed the required training for administration of epinephrine.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 adds an authorization for the administration of a prefilled epinephrine syringe in a current law provision, not addressed by the bill, that authorizes administration of an epinephrine auto-injector by certain school staff.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Jacqué introduced Senate Amendment 1 on June 22, 2021. On January 20, 2022, the Senate Committee on Health voted to recommend adoption of the amendment, and approval of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
