2021 SENATE BILL 392

2021 Senate Bill 392 creates certification requirements for a person practicing as an expanded function dental auxiliary. The Dentistry Examining Board would administer certification and oversight of the profession.

Among its provisions, the bill identifies certain practices that may be performed by an expanded function dental auxiliary, as delegated and supervised by a dentist, including supragingival scaling.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 to the bill removes the authorization for an expanded function dental auxiliary to perform supragingival scaling.

BILL HISTORY

On September 28, 2021, the Senate passed the bill on a vote of Ayes, 31; Noes, 0.

On February 24, 2022, Representative Plumer offered Assembly Amendment 1. That same day, the Assembly adopted the amendment, and concurred in the bill, as amended, on voice votes.
