2021 Senate Bill 969

Senate Amendment 1

2021 SENATE BILL 969

2021 Senate Bill 969 allows the Oneida Nation to post signs denoting that the Oneida Reservation is a Purple Heart Reservation. The signs may be within the right-of-way of any highway within the boundaries of the reservation, except for highways that are a part of the Interstate Highway System.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 allows signs to be placed in the right-of-way of a highway that is a part of the Interstate Highway System if the placement is allowed or approved by the federal government or Federal Highway Administration.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Cowles offered Senate Amendment 1 on February 14, 2022. On February 17, 2022, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Local Government recommended adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and passage of the bill, as amended, both on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
