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




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Decisions for Using Discretionary Supplemental Federal Funds


We requested information on how DOA and the Governor's Office decided to use discretionary funds for nine state programs.

DOA did not provide the requested information but instead provided publicly available information.

DOA indicated that funding decisions were made verbally, rather than in written documents.







Remaining Discretionary Funds

As of June 30, 2022, \$1.8 billion in discretionary supplemental federal funds provided to DOA remained.

In December 2022, DOA indicated it had plans for using most of the remaining funds.







Increasing Transparency

We recommend that DOA:

- document how decisions were made to use discretionary funds for particular state programs; and
- include on its website additional information about supplemental federal funds.

The Legislature could consider modifying statutes to require DOA to periodically report to it specific information about supplemental federal funds.



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
